Appointed by the Secretary of State for Health and accountable to Parliament






## Plain packing changes




## Females prescribed valproate during pregnancy

## Recommendation to NHS England

The Patient Safety Commissioner recommends for NHS England to have a fully funded and resourced system for improving the safe use of the most potent teratogenic medications, through a National Quality Improvement Programme for Integrated Care Systems, starting with the safe use of sodium valproate.


The Commissioner believes that this should be implemented by September 2024 for sodium valproate, before expanding to cover any medication with a Pregnancy Prevention Programme by September 2025.
