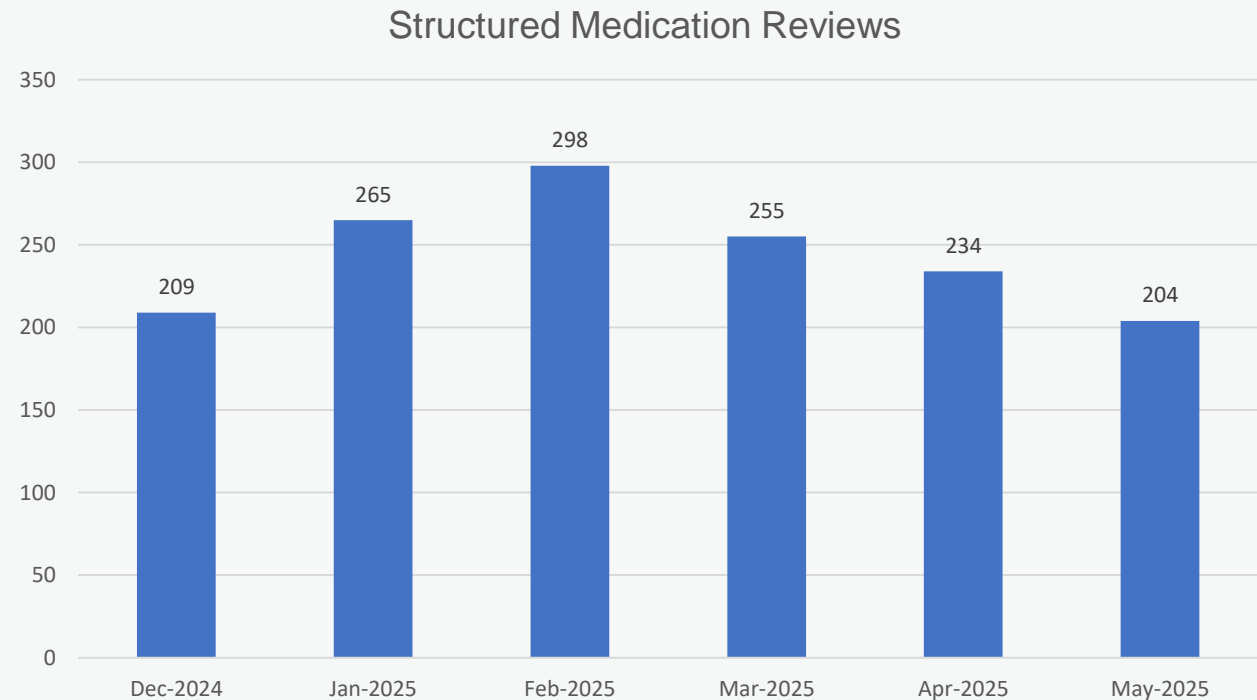


SMR data- sneak peek at trends

The graph shows SMR activity over a 6 month trend.

NB: Providers are working to reduce duplications in recording. Outcomes drop before they rise again

- Data will show 3 month SMR activity per site
- All prisons (regional); Reception prisons and women's prisons
- SMR read code use essential
- Sites should review template use to reduce double entries
- Slide deck shared with HJ chiefs and commissioners in July- expect all sites progress and show SMR activity



Nasal Naloxone- Outcomes and 25/26 plans

Since Jan 2024: HMPPS has enabled volunteer officers to administer nasal naloxone in a suspected opioid overdose



Phase 1

SMS Provider supplies naloxone and trains 5 officers who train others
HMPPS training videos and package for new officers
HMPPS funds service

Outcomes

At April 2025:
Nearly all prisons on board
7000 prison officers trained
Now embedded for volunteers and new officers
Used 536 times since Jan 2024

Phase 2

Legal changes in Dec 2024 enables HMPPS to possess naloxone
NHS service continues for now
HMPPS planning provision to access stock
Transition to exit by NHS SMS 2026
